Read Right gets student back on the basketball court

FORESTBURG (Special) - Kyle Aud could only watch from the sidelines as his classmates participated in sports. He didn't qualify because of poor grades.

That changed for the sophomore a year ago when he began attending a new reading program at his school.

"I never qualified in sixth, seventh or eighth grade," Aud said. "Then, as a freshman, I got to play on the (basketball team.)"

Aud said he really didn't think the program would be any different than others he had been assigned to. But he went along when told to report to the reading lab in the elementary wing of the school.

After only one session in the Read Right program, he was more than ready to return.

"It helped me improve my reading level," he said. "After I noticed it improved my reading, I knew I could do better by trying just a little harder."

By his own admission, Aud never took part in the Accelerated Reader Program (a program in which students are awarded for reading) until this year. With self confidence, Aud said, "Now I enjoy reading."

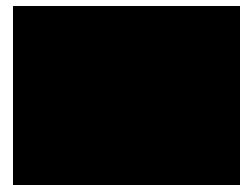
